[Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge](#) is located 220 miles (350km) north of Fairbanks, 60 miles (100km) north of the Arctic Circle, on the edge of Gates of the Arctic National Park.

Your booking provides exclusive use of the entire lodge, we do not book more than one group at a time.

Our trips are all-inclusive, all you have to do is get to Fairbanks and we take care of the rest. We offer a wide range of wilderness opportunities for a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 10 guests. You will have a “concierge guide” available to you for the duration of your trip.

All air transportation is provided by licensed, insured, commercial air charter services.

Our tour prices are per person with no minimum or maximum stay, and no set arrival or departure dates. Our summer season is June 20- September 5 and our winter season is February 20- April 10 each year. Occasionally we can accommodate trips outside of those dates, please contact us with any special requests.

The main lodge at Iniakuk Lake has running water, showers, 24 hour electricity and satellite internet. We have two more properties in Gates of the Arctic National Park, the Arrigetch Peaks Cabin and the Caribou Cabin. Both are more rustic, without constant electricity, and make use of an outhouse instead of running water. The Arrigetch Peaks Cabin is an additional 15 minute flight north of the main lodge and the Caribou Cabin is an additional 50 minute flight north of the main lodge. Your guide will accompany you to the outer cabins, prepare fresh meals each day, and help you explore and enjoy the surrounding wilderness.

Summer Season June 20- September 5
Lodge - based tours

Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge - \$10,175.00 per person

3-night, all-inclusive stay features lodging, all meals, guide with your group for the duration of your stay, and round trip air transportation from Fairbanks.

Our popular 3-night, all-inclusive stay at the [main lodge on Iniakuk Lake](#) can also feature your choice of **one** of the following all-inclusive fly-out adventures. When you base out of the main lodge you will enjoy running water, 24-hour electricity and satellite internet.

3-night stay with Iniakuk Lake Wild & Scenic Float - \$13,100.00 per person

Includes a 4-6 hour Wild & Scenic Float down the outlet of Iniakuk Lake with floatplane pickup, returning to the main lodge in time for dinner.

3-night stay with Gates of the Arctic Caribou Cabin Fly-Out - \$13,100.00 per person

Includes a fly-out day adventure to see the Continental Divide and Gates of the Arctic Caribou Cabin, returning to the main lodge in time for dinner.

3-night stay with Gates of the Arctic National Park Flight-Seeing - \$13,100.00 per person

Includes 4 hours of flight-seeing and hiking through Gates of the Arctic National Park, returning to the main lodge in time for dinner.

3-night stay with National Parks Passport Tour - \$15,180.00 per person

Includes one day of flight-seeing to both Kobuk Valley National Park and Gates of the Arctic National Park, returning to the main lodge in time for dinner.

Summer Season June 20- September 5
Gates of the Arctic Wilderness Cabins

Gates of the Arctic Caribou Cabin on the Continental Divide - \$11,550.00 per person

3-night, all-inclusive stay at our private wilderness cabin in Gates of the Arctic National Park on the Continental Divide. The Caribou Cabin accommodates 4-6.

For the avid hiker wishing to see caribou migrating across the tundra we recommend the Caribou Cabin in August. This remote wilderness cabin is a one hour flight north of the main lodge and accommodates a maximum of six. There is no running water, however a washroom with hot water is provided. Hiking opportunities at this location on the tundra above tree-line are unlimited. Seriously, the hardest part is turning around.



We often see caribou from the front porch, so relaxing with your binoculars is a great option as well. Check out this [guest testimonial](#) combining two nights at Iniakuk Lodge and two nights at the Caribou Cabin.

Gates of the Arctic Arrigetch Wilderness Cabin - \$10,350.00 per person

3-night, all-inclusive stay at our private wilderness cabin in Gates of the Arctic National Park. Located in the heart of the Brooks Range this cabin offers serious hikers a chance to take on some very wild country or float for a few hours on the Wild & Scenic Alatna River. The Arrigetch Cabin accommodates 2-4. Latitude 67.421262, Longitude 153.713428.

Gates of the Arctic Ultimate Tour - \$21,350.00 per person

5-night, all-inclusive stay beginning with 3 nights at the Gates of the Arctic Caribou Cabin and ending with 2 nights at Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge.

National Parks Passport Tour - \$15,180.00 per person

3-night, all-inclusive stay at Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge with one day of flight-seeing to the Kobuk Valley and Gates of the Arctic National Park.



Winter Season February 20- April 10

We offer 3-5 day [guided dog sled](#) trips for every fitness level and each trip starts with a mushing school so you can learn to drive your own team of Alaska huskies. Base out of Iniakuk Lodge for day trips or take off into the Brooks Range and Gates of the Arctic National Park on a multi-day expedition to our Arrigetch Wilderness Cabin. Add a photographer to instruct and document it all.

3-night dog mushing and aurora viewing - \$10,895.00 per person

Fly direct from Fairbanks to Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge and spend 3 days enjoying a few hours of mushing each day and 3 nights taking in the aurora at the main lodge.

4-night dog mushing and aurora viewing - \$13,195.00 per person

Fly direct from Fairbanks to Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge and spend 4 days enjoying a few hours of mushing each day and 4 nights taking in the aurora at the main lodge.

5-night dog mushing and aurora viewing - \$15,795.00 per person

Fly direct from Fairbanks to Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge and spend 5 days enjoying a few hours of mushing each day and 5 nights taking in the aurora at the main lodge.

5-night dog mushing with photographer - \$19,395.00 per person

Fly direct from Fairbanks to Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge and spend 5 days enjoying a few hours of mushing each day with a professional photographer at your side, learn how to photograph the aurora, improve your skills and come home with a well documented trip.

5-night Gates of the Arctic National Park expedition mushing - \$19,995.00 per person

Fly direct from Fairbanks to Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge. Spend 20-30 miles (30-50km) mushing each day. This requires a high level of fitness, we are out all day and sometimes overnight as conditions allow. Attitude is everything, as long as we see smiles we will keep putting on the miles. Warning: May result in overwhelming euphoria.



Our tours include exclusive use of the entire lodge, all meals, recreational equipment, concierge guide with your group for the duration of your stay and round trip air transportation from Fairbanks.

Not included: We do not provide alcohol but you are welcome to bring your own.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION POLICY

Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge will require the signed contract and 20% deposit, along with the original, completed, signed Guest Application and Acknowledgment of Risks form for each trip participant, to confirm all reservations. The deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. The balance is due 90 days prior to the start of the trip and is non-refundable and non-transferable. Reservations made within 90 days of arrival require payment in full which is non-refundable and non-transferable. Due to our short season, we cannot offer refunds on deposits or full payment for any reason.

We accept company/personal check, Visa/MasterCard, and wire transfer until June 5. After June 5, the total tour cost must be made by Visa/MasterCard or wire transfer. We do not accept credit cards for Agent or discounted bookings. We accept Visa/MasterCard for direct bookings. Square is our secure, online credit card vendor for US residents; for non-residents, PayPal.

The remoteness of the area, prevailing weather conditions, and possible cancelled flights may cause substitution of facilities and/or equipment and minor inconveniences, modification or cancellation of the tour. Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge reserves the right to modify and/or cancel arrangements due to unfavorable weather conditions, and to substitute comparable facilities or equipment whenever possible. No refunds can be made for cancelled arrangements due to adverse weather, cancelled flights, or for substitution of facilities and/or equipment or minor inconveniences.

Unforeseen circumstances may result in emergency cancellations. While we share your concern, our remote location makes filling last-minute cancellations impossible. We strictly enforce our Payment and Cancellation Policy. Comprehensive trip insurance is strongly recommended.

Health Protocols

Due to our remote location we urge guests that are experiencing severe flu-like symptoms to stay home. You should also consult your primary care provider if you have had any recent surgeries to be sure to avoid complications. An extremely high level of cleanliness has always been our policy and we have added to our protocols with the spread of Covid-19. We are responding to federal and state mandates and best practices as they change and we will update you with our latest policies during correspondence. The cornerstone of our exclusive and all-inclusive trips is that we only take one booking at a time. Combined with our location, we are one of the most remote, least-peopled lodges on the planet, since 1974.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- All published rates are quoted in USD.
- Rates are based on double occupancy, two-person minimum.
- All air transportation is provided by licensed, insured, commercial air charter service.
- All flights are weather dependent.
- We strictly enforce our Payment and Cancellation Policy. Trip insurance is strongly recommended.
- We accept company/personal check, Visa/MasterCard and wire transfer. We do not accept credit cards for discounted or Agent bookings. We accept Visa/MasterCard for direct bookings. Square is our secure, online vendor for US residents; for non-residents, PayPal.
- Check-in time is 12:00 noon depending on flight scheduling; check-out time is 11:00 a.m. or earlier, depending on flight scheduling.
- Guests with health or dietary restrictions are responsible for disclosing their condition on the required guest application form in advance of arrival.
- Remote facilities are not suitable for children under seven.
- We respectfully request our guests smoke only in designated areas at each facility.
- All fishing is catch and release. Fishing licenses are available at Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge at no additional cost.
- Wearing life vests while canoeing, floating, boating on Iniakuk Lake, fishing from the riverbank or spit is mandatory.
- Spin fishing gear is provided. We provide basic fly fishing equipment. Dry bags are provided for camera and personal gear.
- Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge, LLC, neither owns nor operates any aircraft and is not responsible or liable for failure of any operator and/or equipment to perform and/or any injury, damage or loss regardless of reason.
- Our summer season begins June 20 and ends September 5. Our winter season runs February 20 to April 10.
- Bring soft luggage; do not bring suitcases or wheeled luggage.
- Due to weight and space limitations of a single engine aircraft, personal gear must be restricted to 40 pounds per person.
- Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge, LLC does not provide alcohol; you are welcome to bring your own beer, wine and spirits.
- Iniakuk Lake Wilderness Lodge is solar powered. Items like blow dryers, curling irons and espresso machines draw too much energy for this system.
- Starlink wifi is available in the main lodge.
- No pets please, we have a yard full of dogs ready to add you to the “cuddle puddle.”
- Dog team parking in designated areas only, all others will be towed.
